# Privacy policy of the Gefährliche Arbeit e.V.

## General principles

The collection, processing and use of personal data takes place in the association according to the guidelines of the EU-wide Data Protection Regulation (DS-GVO) and the valid Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG).

When a member joins the association, the member is informed of the data protection law in accordance with Art. 13 Para. 1 and Para. 2 DS-GVO). Upon joining the association, the association may collect all data (application for membership or declaration of membership) that are necessary for the pursuit of the association's objectives and for the support and administration of the members (see Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b) DS-GVO).

## Joining the association

When a member joins, the association records the following personal data:

- First name and surname
- Address (street, house number, postal code, place of residence)
- Communication data (telephone, e-mail)
- date of birth

Each member of the association is also assigned a membership number specific to the association.

The personal data is protected by technical and organizational measures against unauthorized access by third parties.

Through your membership and the associated acceptance of these statutes, you agree to the processing of your personal data to the aforementioned extent and scope.

Within the framework of the legal regulations, in particular the DSGVO and the BDSG, every member has the right to information about the data stored about their own person, their recipients and the purpose of storage, as well as to correction, deletion or blocking, restriction, objection and transferability of their own data.

Upon termination of membership, personal data will be deleted as soon as their knowledge is no longer required.

The Board of Directors does not appoint a data protection officer to monitor data protection regulations, as fewer than 10 people are employed by the company.
